



Code of Conduct: Club Player

Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with their Coach, Team Manager or another adult club member that they trust.

Any breaches of the code of conduct may be subject to the clubs disciplinary process.

Junior Members (under 18 years) are expected to:

- Treat others with the respect and fairness that I would like them to show me, this includes the use of social networking sites;
- Understand and play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions;
- Respect opponents/team-mates, and behave in a manner that shows this respect both on and off the court;
- Control tempers and avoid behaviour which may cause inconvenience or upset others;
- Keep to agreed timings for training sessions/competitions or inform their coach or Team Manager if they are going to be late;
- Wear suitable kit for training and matches, as agreed with the Coach/Team Manager: t-shirt (club t-shirts are available), shorts, indoor suitable trainers and knee-pads (if desired);
- Not wear jewellery for any training sessions or matches;
- Pay any fees for training or events promptly (access to sessions may be prevented without payment);
- Not consume any substances that will lead to the name of either yourself or the club being denigrated;
- Set a positive example for others, particularly younger athletes and spectators and not use foul language, abusive or offensive language;
- Accept success and failure in a selfless and positive way;
- Take care of all property, both personal and that of the club;
- Thank those responsible for organising any event;
- Respect the coaching staff and support the coaching and development of the wider club where appropriate.
